Location: The car park and event centre are at the Ageas Bowl, Botley Road, West End, Southampton, Hampshire, SO30 3XH.
Main entrance at Grid ref: SU477143.
Follow official road signs to the Ageas Bowl. Drive through the main entrance and up the hill to the far end. Park in Car Park 6 (if there is space) or in the bays on the access road near there. There should be plenty of space.
Registration and download are in the Arthur Holt Pavilion which is at the far end (east end) of the site.

Courses close: 13:15

Facilities: Changing facilities and toilets. Bring your own drinks.

Entry: Entry on the day only. Members of British Orienteering do not need to complete an entry form. Please help us to keep registration flowing by bringing your EMIT card with you if you have one.
