Summer Series Event 8 Incorporating Club BBQ & Summer Series Prize Giving

Saturday 17TH July 2010 at Royal Victoria Country Park

Directions: The entrance to the Park is at grid reference SU 458080.
From M27 junction 8, follow brown tourist signs for Royal Victoria CP. Head south along A3025 & B3997 before turning right at the 4th roundabout towards Netley.
At the park entrance follow signs to the BBQ areas & overflow car-park.
Parking, registration, start/finish and BBQ are all be within 100m.

Parking fee: There is a £2 parking fee at RVCP. Please use the pay and display machines within the Park. Please bring change as the machines don't take notes.

The Event: **Courses** - Yellow 2.3k, Orange 3.0k, Green(ish) 4.5k
The Green course will fall between TD4 and TD5. The terrain is physically easy.
Times - Registration from 09.45, Starts 10.00 – 12.00. Courses close 13.00.
Fees - Seniors £3.00, Juniors £1.00. Emit hire free.
Map - A4, scale 1:5000, minor updates July 2010.
Help, instruction and coaching is available, just ask anyone who looks like they know what they're doing!
Planners Notes: There are small access roads running through the competition area. All courses cross these so please take care. There is a 15mph speed limit within RVCP and some big bumps. Some routes also cross the miniature railway line. Beware of trains. All courses go alongside the lakes/swamps at the North edge of the map. Out of bounds areas must be avoided by all competitors.

The BBQ: All orienteers (members & non members) are invited to join us for a BBQ following the event. The BBQ will be available from 11.15 to 15.30.
SOC will supply the charcoal, lighters etc. Please bring your own food, drink, plates, utensils & cutlery. There are picnic tables available at the BBQ site but it will help is you can bring some chairs. Please note disposable BBQs are not allowed in the Park.

The Prize-giving: The prize giving will take place as soon as the overall results are known. Medals will be awarded for overall 1st, 2nd & 3rd junior and 1st, 2nd & 3rd senior on each of the 3 courses in the Summer Series.
Certificates of achievement will be presented to all juniors and senior new-comers who have completed 3 or more courses during the Summer Series.
